WHAT IS THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY SEAL OF MULTILITERACY?

The Seal of Multiliteracy is a recognition given by the Riverside County Office of Education in partnership with districts, in recognition of high levels of attained proficiency in English and at least one other world language by high school graduation.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- High school students who are seniors during the current Seal process.
- High school students who demonstrate proficiency in English.
- High school students who demonstrate proficiency in a language other than English.

REQUIREMENTS

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Complete all English Language Arts (ELA) requirements for graduation with an overall unweighted GPA of 2.00 or above.

Pass the CAASPP in ELA (administered in grade eleven), at or above the "standard met" achievement level.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR STUDENTS CURRENTLY CLASSIFIED AS "ENGLISH LEARNERS"

Demonstrate English language proficiency on ELPAC, or any previous or successor state English language proficiency assessment.

Note: Proficiency means an overall performance level with a score of 4 "welldeveloped" on the Summative ELPAC Assessment.

SECOND LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Pass either an Advanced Placement (AP) exam with a three or above or an International Baccalaureate (IB) exam with a four or above by the deadline.

Students who do not meet one of the above criteria may demonstrate proficiency in another language by passing the Riverside County On-Demand Assessment.

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
