Dr. Veronica Alvarez is an educator, historian, and arts advocate. As a leader in arts education, Dr. Alvarez has served as an education consultant for other entities such as the UCLA's Fowler Museum and Chicano Studies Research Center, LMU's Family of Schools, the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, the U.S. State Department as an English Specialist in Serbia, and State Department of Cultural Affairs in Chiapas, Mexico. She also created online and blended learning models on arts integration with the Teaching Channel and the Los Angeles County Office of Education, where she worked with coaches from 70 school districts.
