PBIS Tier 1 Team Training

Join our PBIS Tier 1 Team Training to support district and school site teams in leveraging their Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) framework to implement Tier 1 PBIS. Teams will engage in learning how to create safe, positive, predictable, and equitable learning environments for ALL students. This training is designed for district and school site teams to support students and adults through developing a framework that integrates school mental wellness, social-emotional learning, and culturally-responsive teaching. This training will be offered in two tracks to support various implementation needs. Site teams will progress as cohorts. All trainings will be presented virtually.
