Integration Themes:

Art, English/Language Arts, and Science

Summary:

Want to learn more about the birds and their nests? This book is a perfect read out loud with a touch of humor and compassion for our friends with wings in the sky!

Materials:

Brown paper lunch bag, assorted scraps of paper, ribbon, straw, twigs, grass or feathers.

Directions:

- Crumple up the paper bag and then shape it into a circle to resemble the round shape of a bird's nest.
- 2. Push it down in the center so that the middle of the nest is deeper than its outer edges.
- 3. Gently layer the various materials you have collected using several dots of glue on each piece you add to the nest.
- 4. Once it's dry, you can add elements like eggs or baby chicks to complete the project.
