PBIS Tier 1 Team Training

Join our virtual PBIS Tier 1 Team Training to support district and school site teams in leveraging their Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) framework to implement Tier 1 Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS). Teams will engage in learning how to create safe, positive, predictable, and equitable learning environments – for ALL students and staff – that integrate school mental health, social-emotional learning, and culturally-responsive teaching. This training will be offered at two levels – Year 1 and Year 2 – to support various implementation needs. All trainings will be presented virtually.
